MAIN PREMISES

- Current solutions do not support new service models and are difficult to develop.
- Need to proceed towards variable, individual and flexible service solutions and service design.
- Need to build customer oriented ICT solutions based on key functional modules.
- Need to utilize more effectively the fast development of ICT infrastructures and technologies.
- Need to break off vendor lock-in.

Regional government, social and healthcare reform 2019

- Integrated social and healthcare services will be organized by 18 different counties
 - *Changing roles for municipalities*
- Funding will be provided by the state and channeled through counties
- Distinction between organizer and provider
- Multiple service providers (county and private organizations)
- Change of responsibilities for social and helathcare ICT solutions

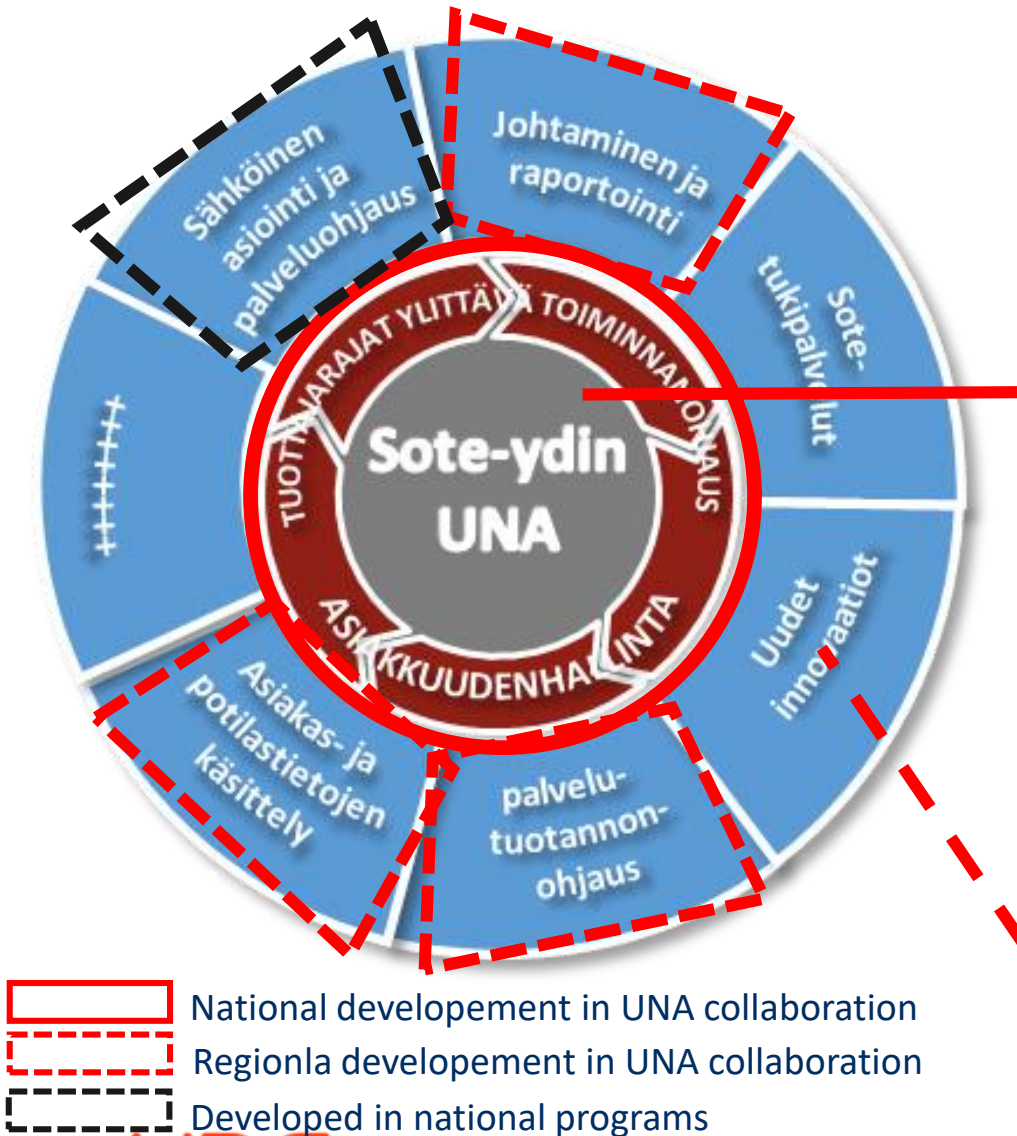
- Analysis and description of tendering, procurement and implementation models

VISION:ECOSYSTEM BASED ON MODULAR ARCHITECTURE



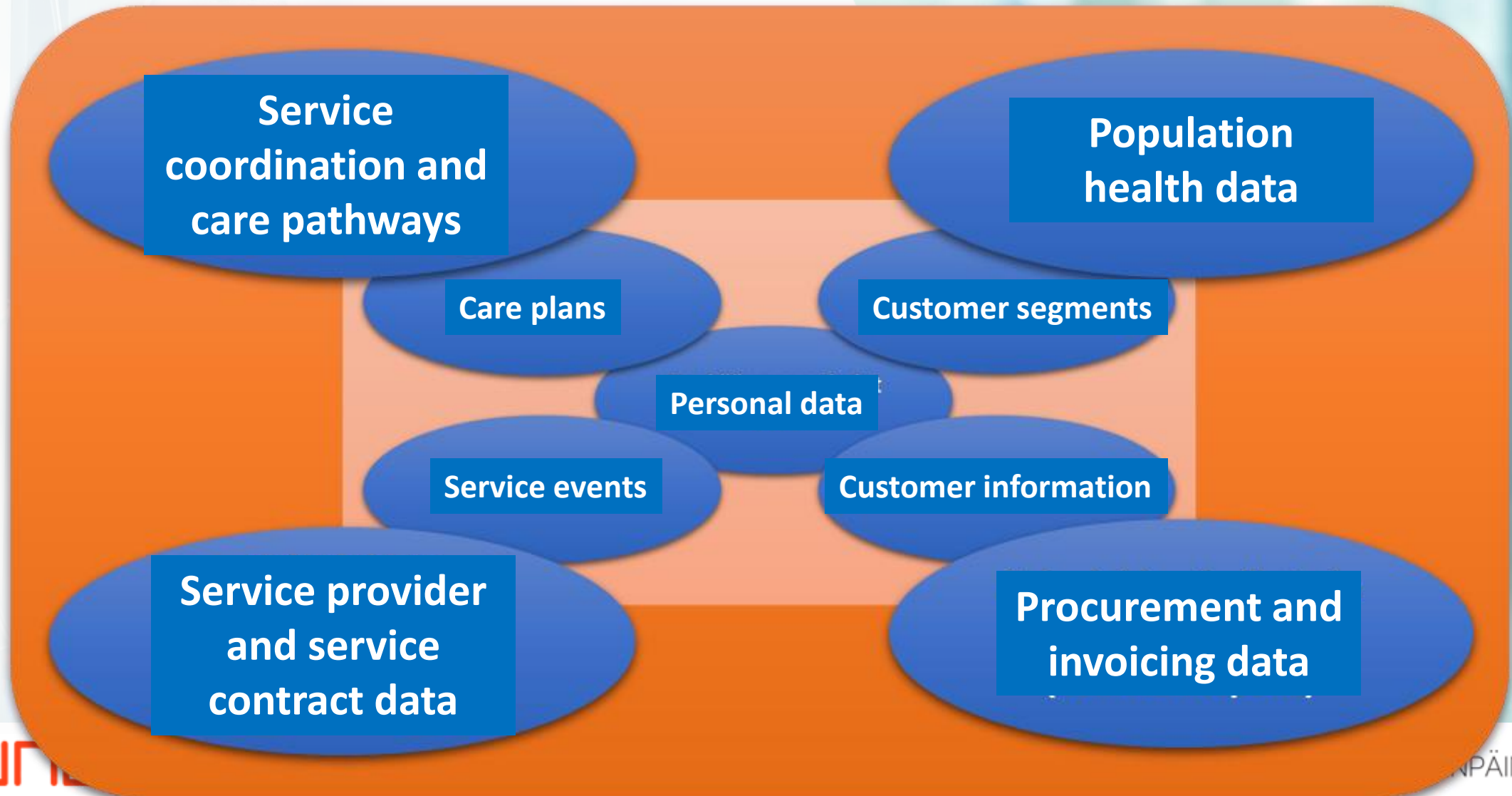
CORE SYSTEM

- Customer relations management supports executing customer oriented care processes across multiple providers
- Supports steering of customer's service packages and resource/service allocations
- Takes care of integration with national services and provides open interfaces for the ecosystem's modular parts and user interfaces and provides the platform for interoperability.
- Information and data management solution supporting the interoperability

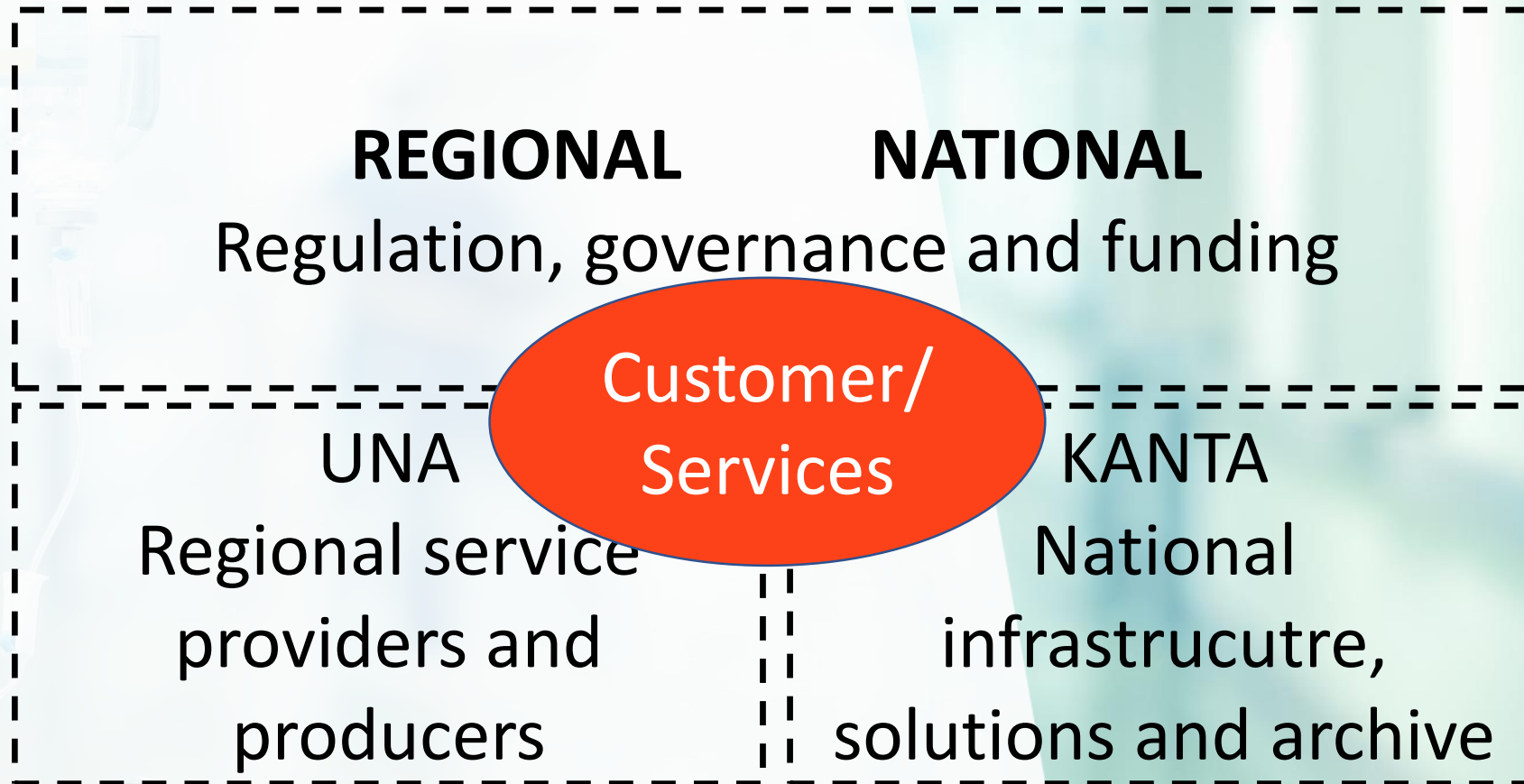
Solutions implemented in co-operation

POSITIONING OF UNA

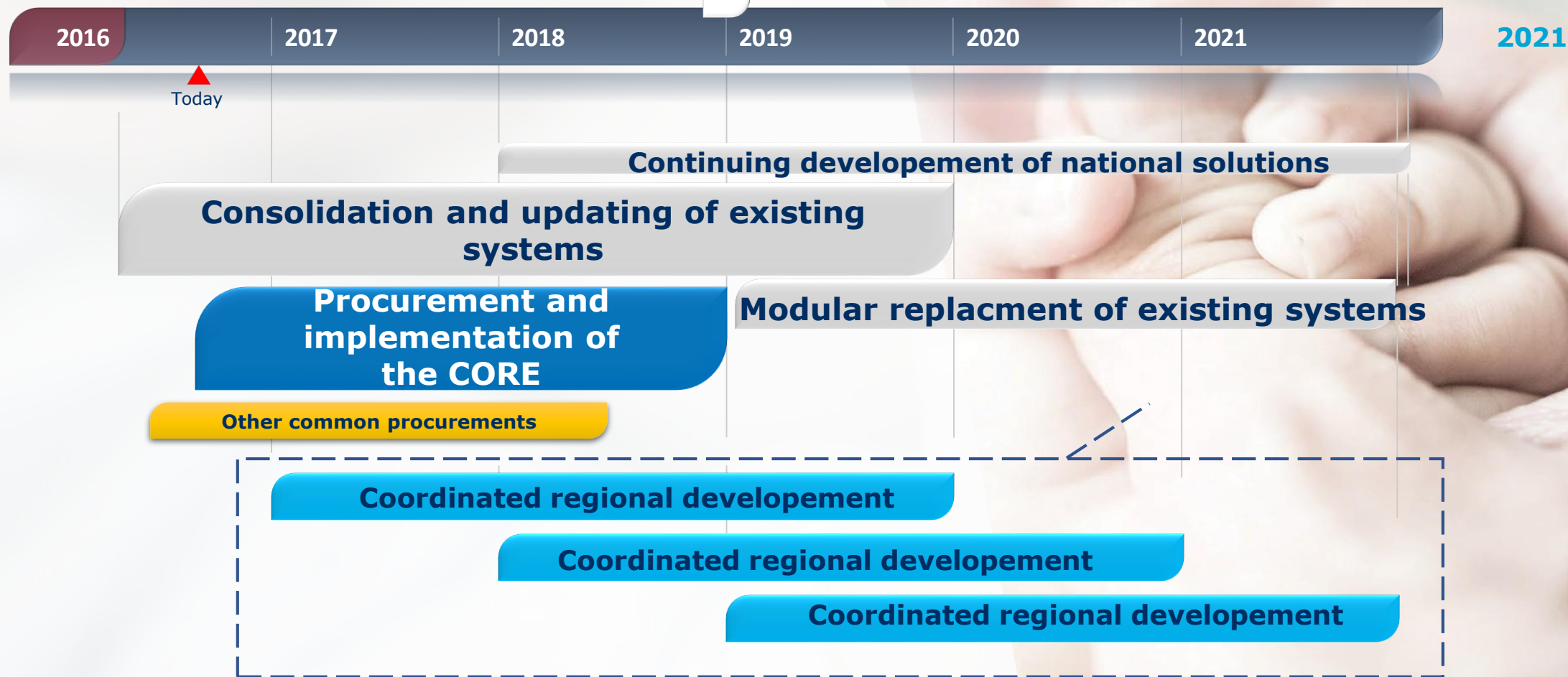


DYNAMIC ENVIRONMENT
